Exclusions

- Rust on the product due to insufficient care and maintenance, which is not covered under this warranty.

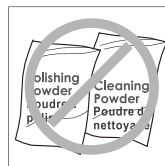
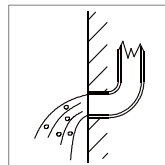

♦ Installation and Maintenance Matters

1. Check the accessories list to verify that all parts are complete in this package.
2. Do not disassemble the main body by yourself.
3. Connect inlet pipes to supply valves.
4. Make sure inlet pipes and supply valves have no impurities and are cleaned, with no impurities in the pipeline.
5. After installation, check all joints for leakages.
6. Do not leave the bathtub faucet system exposed to a severely corrosive environment.



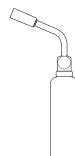
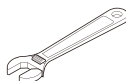
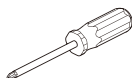
Do's

1. In order to keep the mixer surface bright, please clean the mixer regularly.
2. Rinse the faucet with clean water and wipe it with a soft cotton cloth.
3. Use one of the following cleaners to remove dirt from the surface: a. Mild liquid cleaner. b. Colorless glass cleaner and powder cleaner that do not cause abrasion and can be dissolved completely. c. Polish liquid that does not cause abrasion.

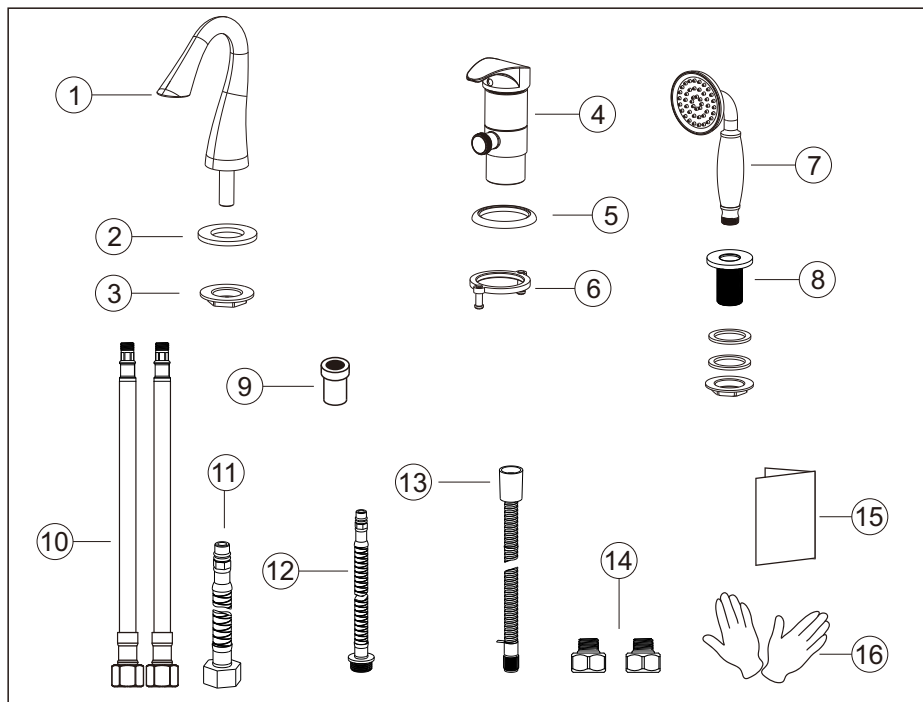
Don'ts

- a. Avoid using cleaning powder, harsh cleaning chemicals, brushes and coarse cloth to prevent scratching and friction.
- b. Do not use acid cleaners to clean the faucet as they may cause surface corrosion of the faucet. If the faucet is exposed to harmful acid substances, please rinse it immediately with water.

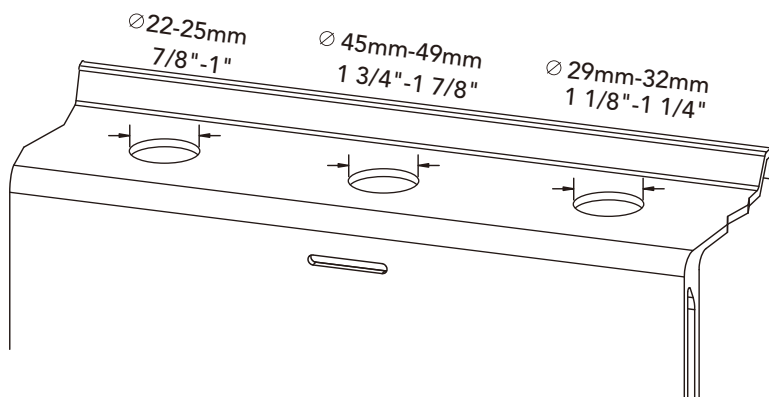

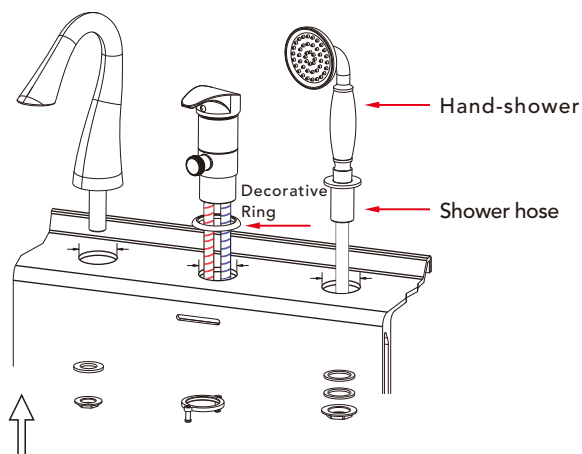
◆ Bathtub Faucet Installation

Step 1



1. Refer to the drilling locations and dimensions in the diagram to make the holes in the bathtub.

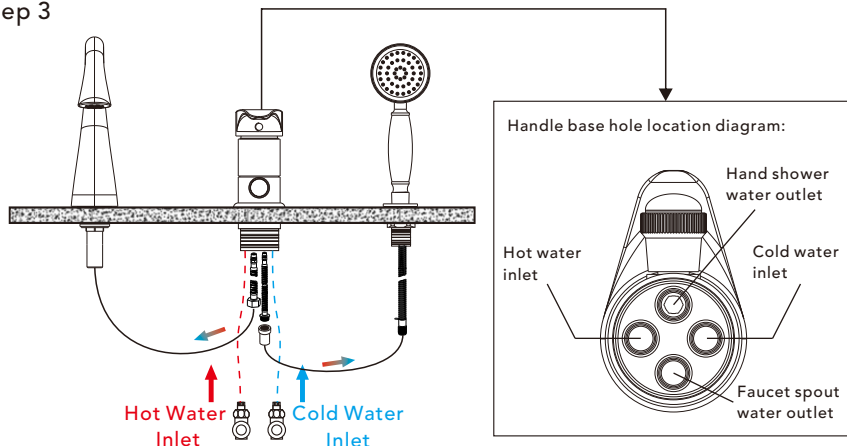
Step 2



2. Insert the faucet body, handle, and shower holder through their respective holes and place them on the bathtub surface. From underneath, slide on the washers, and finally secure them by tightening the lock nuts.

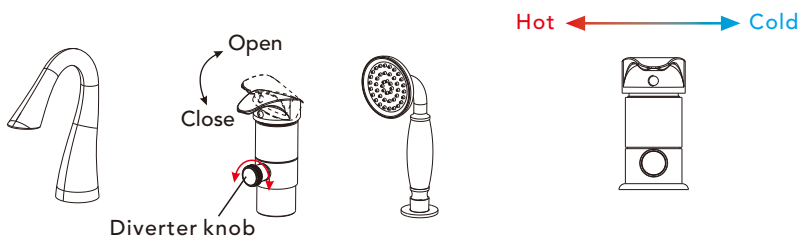

Step 3



1. Connect the cold and hot water supply lines to the two corresponding ports underneath the handle assembly. Connect the remaining third and fourth ports to the outlet pipes. (which runs to the spout).
2. Beneath the spout, connect the outlet hose (from the valve) to one port. Connect the shower hose to the remaining port.
3. Feed the other end of the shower hose through the shower holder (bracket). Finally, connect it securely to the hand shower.

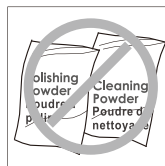
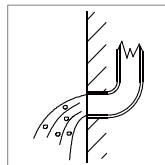
Step 4



1. To operate the water flow: Lift the handle to turn the water on. Move the handle to the left for hot water and to the right for cold water.
2. To change the water outlet: Rotate the diverter knob on the spout clockwise or counterclockwise to switch the water flow between the spout and the hand shower.

♦ Instalación y cuestiones de mantenimiento

1. Verifique la lista de accesorios para comprobar que todas las partes están completas en este paquete.
2. No desmonte el cuerpo principal por sí mismo.
3. Conecte las tuberías de entrada a las válvulas de suministro.
4. Asegúrese de que las tuberías de entrada y las válvulas de suministro no tengan impurezas y estén limpias, sin impurezas en la tubería.
5. Después de la instalación, verifique todas las uniones para detectar fugas.
6. No deje el sistema de grifería para bañera expuesto a un entorno fuertemente corrosivo.



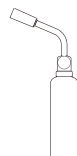
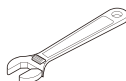
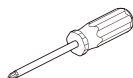
Hacer

1. En para mantener la superficie de la batidora brillante, limpie el mezclador regularmente.
2. Inse el grifo con agua limpia y límpielo con un suave ropa de algodón.
3. Utilice uno de los siguientes limpiadores para eliminar la suciedad de la superficie: a. Limpiador líquido suave. b. Limpiador de vidrio incoloro y limpiador en polvo que no causen abrasión y que se puedan disolver completamente. c. Líquido pulidor que no cause abrasión.

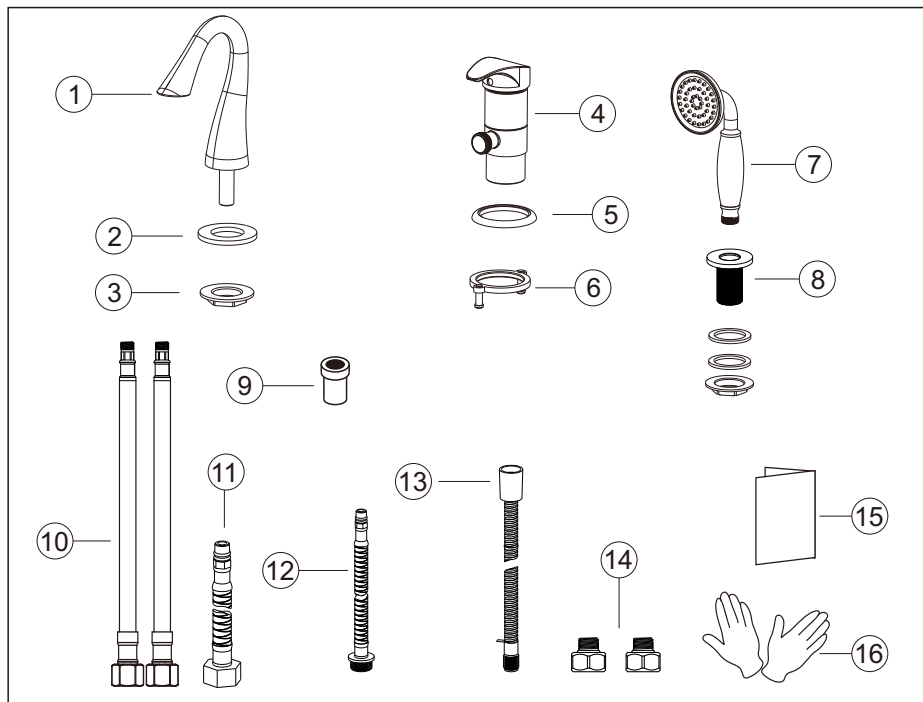
No es decir

- A. Valte con polvo de limpieza, productos químicos de limpieza duros, cepillos y tela gruesa para evitar rascar y fricción.
- B. No use limpiadores de ácidos para limpiar el grifo, ya que pueden causar corrosión superficial del grifo. Si el grifo está expuesto a sustancias ácidas dañinas, enjuague inmediatamente con agua.

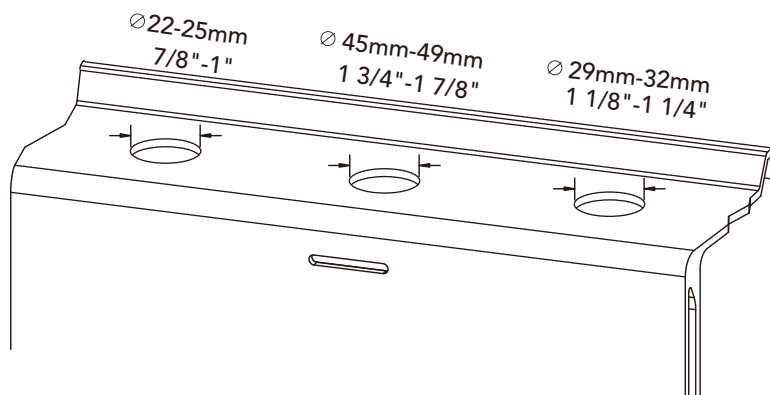

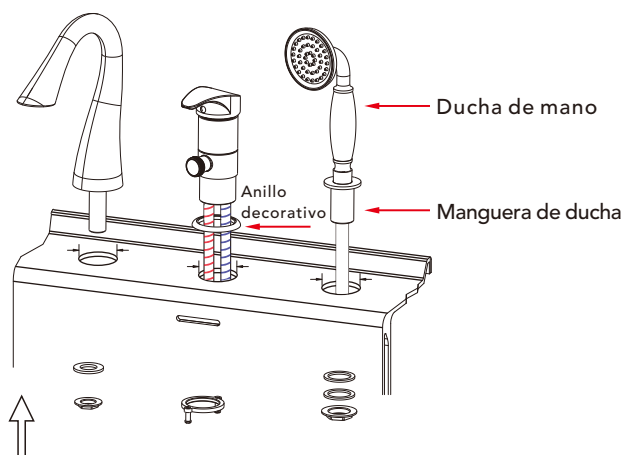
◆ Instalación del Grifo para Bañera

Paso 1



1. Consulte las ubicaciones de perforación y las dimensiones en el diagrama para realizar los agujeros en la bañera.

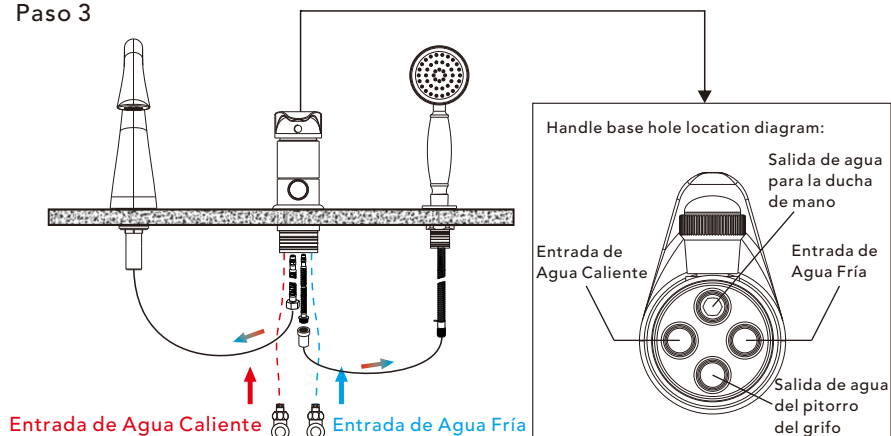
Paso 2



2. Inserte el cuerpo del grifo, la manija y el soporte de ducha a través de sus respectivos orificios y colóquelos sobre la superficie de la bañera. Desde la parte inferior, deslice las arandelas y finalmente fíjelos apretando las tuercas de seguridad.

◆ Instalación del Grifo para Bañera

Paso 3



1. Conecte las líneas de suministro de agua fría y caliente a las dos entradas correspondientes situadas debajo del conjunto de la manija. Conecte las terceras y cuartas entradas restantes a las tuberías de salida (que conducen al surtidor).
2. Debajo del surtidor, conecte la manguera de salida (proveniente de la válvula) a una de las entradas. Conecte la manguera de ducha a la entrada restante.
3. Pase el otro extremo de la manguera de ducha a través del soporte (o brazo) de la ducha. Finalmente, conéctela firmemente a la ducha de mano.

Paso 4



1. Para abrir el flujo de agua: levante la manija para encender el agua. Mueva la manija hacia la izquierda para obtener agua caliente y hacia la derecha para agua fría.
2. Para cambiar la salida de agua: gire la perilla del desviador en el surtidor en el sentido de las agujas del reloj o en sentido contrario para cambiar el flujo de agua entre el surtidor y la ducha de mano.
